- What is it?** Cub Scout Camp is great time for Cub Scouts to have 4 fun-filled days of archery, shooting BB's, crafts, playing sports and games, racing and A WHOLE LOT MORE. On Wednesday through Friday, you will gather with other friends from your den and pack and spend the entire evening having fun. On Friday evening, we have a program for your whole family and a lock-in overnight. Saturday morning we will have pancakes for everybody!
- Boys do not have to have been a Cub Scout prior to attending Cub camp. In fact, Cub camp is a perfect way to let boys "try on" Cub Scouting.! Hereford Cub Camp is a fun outdoor activity for all Hereford boys currently in Kindergarten through 4th grade.
- When?** Hereford Cub Camp is Wednesday, July 7 through Saturday, July 10 from 5:30 pm until 9 pm. The Cub overnighter on Friday ends with breakfast on Saturday (July 10) morning.
- Where?** This year Hereford Cub Camp will be held at Hereford Church of the Nazarene (1410 La Plata St).
- Supervision?** We encourage all parents to join their children at Cub Camp. For Friday's Cub overnighter, every child must be supervised by an adult.
- Cost?** \$50 per Cub Scout. Fee covers t-shirt, patch, light dinner each evening, Saturday breakfast and program supplies. If paying after June 16, the cost increases to \$60. Fee is non-refundable, but can be transferred to another scout. Leaders attend camp at no cost. If they would like to purchase a T-shirt for \$12, they can do so on the registration form. Camperships are available for scouts who need help with camp fees.
- Food?** Light meals will be provided each evening for scout and adult leaders/parent. Pancake breakfast will be provided Saturday morning for those scouts and families camping over Friday night.
- Registration:** Pre-registration is necessary. Contact your Cubmaster or Den Leader for information. Please complete application on following pages and return to your Pack Cub Camp coordinator or Cubmaster.
- Insurance:** Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members and leaders of the Golden Spread Council.
