

2010 Cub Scout Resident Camp

Webelos Only- Camp Don Harrington

- What is it?** Resident Camp is a great summer overnight camp for Cub Scouts (Webelos – boys entering the 4th and 5th grades in the fall). It is a 3- day experience where Scouts can shoot BB guns, bow and arrow, learn about nature, do leatherwork and crafts, play games, work on badges, swimming, and do lots more activities. Leaders and boys alike have a great time.
- When?** Friday, June 18th through Sunday, June 20th, 2010 and/or Friday, June 25th through Sunday, June 27th, 2010. Camp begins with check-in on Friday from noon until 4 pm and will conclude on Sunday at noon.
- Where?** Camp Don Harrington located south of Amarillo along South Washington Ave. (FM 1541).
- Supervision?** Scouts should register with their PACK (not individually). Each pack must provide one leader for every five boys (a minimum of two leaders per pack). Parents are encouraged to participate. If you are Staff, do not count yourself in this total. Leaders need to complete a separate application for medical purposes. The camp is operated by BSA-certified volunteer staff with a health professional on site.
- Cost?** \$85 per scout, but is \$70 if paid before June 2nd. Fee covers a t-shirt, patch, program supplies, and meals.
- The adult fee is \$50 and includes a t-shirt and meals.
- Fee is non-refundable, but can be transferred to another scout.
- Food?** All meals will be provided by the camp and are included in the registration fee. If any special dietary needs need to be addressed, please contact the Council Office at least two weeks before the start date of camp.
- What to Bring?** Tents will not be provided. A detailed list of other items that will be needed is listed below. There will be a Trading Post available to purchase Snacks, Drinks, and Scout items.
- Registration:** Pre-registration is necessary. Complete the attached registration form (pg 3) and turn in to your Cubmaster or Committee Chairperson along with Part A & C of the Annual Health and Medical Record for each Scout and Adult (if staying at camp). - Insurance:** Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance is provided for all registered members and leaders of the Golden Spread Council.
