

Addendum to Camp Don Usage Policy

From time to time a fire ban is imposed at Camps Don Harrington and/or MK Brown by the state, county, or other authority. During times of fire ban, units will not be authorized to have any type of fire.

If the National Weather Service indicates a Fire Weather Warning or Elevated Fire Weather Conditions exists the area of the camp, campfires and charcoal grill cooking will not be allowed. In addition, if winds (at the time of the anticipated fire) are in excess of 15 miles per hour, no fires will be allowed. Propane grills are allowed. The Camp Ranger is the final authority as he had direct access to the weather report and the local Fire Department to make the best decision.

If the above is not applicable, the camp provided "Fire Pit" or similar product supplied by the unit shall be used. Charcoal grills are allowed as long as a lid can control the sparks. Propane grills are preferred. In all cases, water and a hose must be available in the campsite.
