- What is it?** Merit Badge University is an opportunity for Boy Scouts to work on Merit Badges that they have an interest in for advancement. This year a variety of training programs will also be offered to adult leaders accompanying the troops.
- When & Where?** Saturday, January 23rd – West Texas A&M University in Canyon, Texas (see map on page 5). We will begin registration at the Virgil Henson Activities Center which is # 28 on the map and located on Russell Long Boulevard. Parking is located in front of the center. Signs will be posted. All parking will be at this facility throughout the day. Tickets will be issued by the Campus Police Department to those who park in an unauthorized location on campus.
- Check-in begins at 8am through 8:45am with the opening ceremony/welcome at 8:45am. Classes start at 9am and conclude at 4:15pm. Camp Don Harrington is available for troops who would like to camp-over Friday and/or Saturday night.
- Supervision?** Supervision is the responsibility of the units. A unit must have two-deep leadership.
- Cost?** Boy Scouts - \$25 Fees for Scouts include breakfast snacks, lunch and supplies.
Adult Leaders - \$10 Fees for adults include breakfast snacks, lunch and supplies. As a reminder, you must have at least two adult registered leaders at this event at all times and any others who remain at the event must pay as well.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available, but fees are transferable to another scout or adult.
- Registration:** Pre-registration is required. Please return the form below (along with sign-up forms and fees) to the Scout Office **no later than Wednesday, January 13th**. **Absolutely no registrations will be accepted after this date- NO EXCEPTIONS so plan accordingly.**
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members and leaders of the Golden Spread Council.
