



National Youth Leadership Training

Sunday, June 6 – Friday, June 11, 2010

Camp Don Harrington, Amarillo

What is it? National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) 6-day program integrates the best of modern leadership theory with the traditional strengths of the Scouting experience to train young men to better serve their troops when placed in leadership positions. Boy Scouts who are at least 13 years of age (and have completed the seventh grade) and have earned the rank of First Class are eligible to participate. Here's a brief outline of what Scouts can expect to accomplish during this training:

Day One: Communicating Well, Finding Your Vision

Day Two: Setting Your Goals; Preparing Your Plans

Day Three: Forming Your Team; Problem Solving; Leading EDGE (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide, Enable)

Day Four: Resolving Conflicts; Making Ethical Decisions

Day Five: Leading Yourself; Valuing People

Day Six: Communicating Well, Creating A Future

Why? Boy Scout troops have plenty of willing youth leaders, but many of them are missing or lacking the skills that would help them to be effective. This course builds on troop level training by placing a troop's scouts in different surroundings with a different group of boys. Concepts and work processes are introduced and then built upon, through the use of memory aids, which result in participants understanding and employing the leadership skills they have learned faster and better.

When? The NYLT course begins on Sunday, June 6th at 1:00 pm and ends Friday, June 11th at 4:30 pm. Parents are invited to the closing ceremony on Friday. Prior to the course, participants are required to attend a one-hour course orientation, accompanied by a troop adult leader, at either one of the following locations:

Sunday, May 16 at 2:00 pm at Camp Don Harrington

Thursday, May 27 at 7:00 pm at First United Methodist Church in Pampa, Texas

Where? Course will be held at Camp Don Harrington, south of Amarillo, TX.

Cost? Participant fee is \$100. A deposit of \$50 must accompany each application. The remainder is due by check-in on Sunday, June 6th. Refunds will not be available after May 16th, but fees are transferable to another participant.

Registration? Applications from participants will be accepted through Sunday, May 16th.
