Class Information – Cost \$15 – 8 hour course – Age limit – 9 years old and up. Mr. Forney needs each person email address so he can set up online registration for each applicant before class. {He would like to take care of this before coming to camp}. Also any scout wanting to take this class will not be able to sign up for any of the merit badge classes for this camp the hunters education will be the only thing they can take!!! {Please Make Contact With Mr. Forney Before Camp}.

What to Bring?

- Scouts must bring clothing that can get dirty or ruined while doing the merit badge. They should read about the merit badge they want to take and see if they need supplies such as writing material or any special supplies and bring it. They will need a merit badge work book and work sheet to bring to class.
- Meals will be provided by Troops. Whatever it takes to feed your unit, you must bring! Example: If your unit wants 2 pieces of sausage for breakfast and you have a head count of 10 it would take 20 pieces to feed your unit $10 \times 2 = 20$. We also ask that you bring enough food to feed 2 extra people per unit. Meals will be prepared by Kitchen staff and served. You must turn in all your food to the Kitchen staff at Check-in before setting up your campsite. **“You must also provide Paper Plates, Cups, Paper Towels and Eating Utensils for your Unit”**.
- **{FOOD YOU MUST BRING}**. Jimmy Dean Fully Cooked Sausage Patties 24 count, Eggs, Frozen Waffles, Instant Oatmeal, Butter, Syrup, Muffins, Juice, Hot Chocolate, 2 pounds of Hamburger Meat, Two Party Size Bags of Frito Chips, Two Packets of McCormick Mild Chilly Mix, Two Boxes of Saltine Crackers, Loafs of Bread, Cookies.
