WHO:

This event is open to ALL Cub Scouts (Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears, Webelos, & Arrow of Light) and their families. Siblings may participate in most activities but please allow Cub Scouts to do the activities first so they all get a chance. Siblings in Kindergarten and below cannot shoot BB Guns as it is against National BSA Policy for children 5 years of age and under to shoot BB Guns.

Additional limitations may occur dependent on specific camp activities. If you have multiple Cub Scouts, they each should be registered as Cub Scout participants to be allowed full participation.

HOW:

1. Check with your unit leaders to make sure which weekend your Pack will be attending. You do not have to attend with your Pack if you cannot make the weekend they choose. Most Cubs will attend with their fellow Pack members, however your Cub Scout and adult parent/guardian may attend separate from your Pack.

2. Register online at www.goldenspread.org to attend the event. Make sure and choose the correct weekend and camp location. There is an option for registration of your Cub Scout and any siblings 5 years old & up that will be attending. Please know the total number of adults that will be attending with your Cub Scout. They are free of charge, however you will need to list how many to expect.

CAMPING INFORMATION



CAMP DON HARRINGTON

- Overnight Campers (Friday and Saturday night camping is available) **arrive between 6pm-7:30pm Friday and 9am-10:30am Saturday. This will give you plenty of time to get to your site and setup. NO Program or food will be available so plan accordingly.**
- Please note **NO** vehicles will be allowed to campsites for gear drop-off after 10:30am.
- Each unit that plans to camp **MUST** reserve their campsite by contacting the Scout Office and completing the reservation form at least **ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE WEEKEND** you are attending. This must be done prior to arriving at camp. Make your reservations soon as campsites fill very quickly! Call 806-358-6500 for more info.
- All vehicles will remain in the parking lot throughout the evening, you may take one vehicle per campsite with Ranger approval to pick up gear. The camp gate will remain closed for your security throughout the night. As per camp policy, the gate will be locked for entry after 11pm, however you may leave in an emergency.
- Please follow all camp rules and policies that your unit will receive when they make the reservation to camp.
- See packing list for recommended items to pack for both day and overnight camp use.

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PACKING LIST

SPOOK-O-REE DAY EVENT



- Dress in comfortable, weather appropriate clothing, and wear shoes suitable for walking.
- Don't forget a **jacket**. It tends to get chilly towards evening in the fall.
- Bring a small **backpack** or bag to hold a **water bottle**, candy, and other papers/maps.
- We recommend bringing sunscreen and bug spray.
- Most units will wear their Activity Uniform (Pack t-shirt) or the Spook-o-REE shirt
- Bring a camping chair and/or blanket to sit on the ground with at various activities
- Bring some money for concessions if you didn't buy them online!
- Don't forget your **flashlight** to see when you are walking around camp in the dark. The Spook Walk and Haunted House do NOT allow flashlights to be on.
- If you are attending with several small children, we recommend to bring a wagon to pull your bags and such around to the activities. It makes it much more enjoyable than carrying!
- There will be a lot of walking to the event areas. Make sure and bring a stroller for your little ones that can handle dirt roads.
- Each Cub Scout participant will receive an event patch. After the events there may be additional patches available for purchase at the Scout Shop. This year, you will receive your patch AFTER the event through your Pack leadership.
- Spook-o-REE T-shirts must be ordered prior to event. If there are any extra t-shirts, those will be available for purchase at the Scout Shop after the event.

OVERNIGHT CAMPING AT SPOOK-O-REE

- In addition to the daytime items listed above you will need to bring any extra changes of clothes; keep in mind the weather and temperatures we may be experiencing. If the weather is cold at night please make sure to pack warm weather clothes, jacket, gloves, and a blanket.
- **Tent** with a groundcover tarp for underneath
- **Sleeping bag** or bedding & pillow
- Cot or **air mattress**
- **Lantern & flashlight**
- **Camping chair**
- Cooler with evening snacks and morning food (meals are not provided by council)
- Personal toiletries (showers are available)

COVID-19 OVERVIEW

We are aware of the concerns you may have regarding COVID-19 and this event. We have reviewed, with each of the Camp Directors and Program Committee, what our guidelines will be for the event. They include the following:

^ Each activity will have Hand Sanitizer and we will require that each participant, Scout and Adult, receive one pump of Hand Sanitizer before participating.

^ The Midway will be cordoned off with only one authorized entry and exit. The entry will be setup with a hand sanitizing table and each participant, Scout and Adult, will receive one pump of Hand Sanitizer before participating.

^ The equipment that will be used will be sanitized by an adult staff member before use at their discretion.

^ There will be limitations on participants on any Inflatable Game at the event. No more than 5 scouts at one time and each must receive one pump of Hand Sanitizer before entering the activity. Shoes may not be worn. Sanitization of the inflatable after each use will be determined by the owner of the inflatable and their recommendations to keep everyone safe.

^ Trading Post will be available at each camp and there will be limits on how many are in the Trading Post at one time. Social Distancing will be enforced.

^ Mask will not be mandatory but encouraged. Social Distancing will be enforced by adult staff and help of each leader and parent. We cannot do this alone- we need your help to keep everyone as safe as possible.

^ All participants, including Troop member's must complete the Covid-19 Medical Pre-Departure Pre-Event Form (See page 9- make as many copies as you need and/or forward to all parents and leaders) and each must be signed. Parents are required to sign the form for their Scout. Missing signatures will require the individual to be turned away at the gate or isolated from the group until signatures can be obtained.

^ Every participant upon arrival will have their temperature checked using a Contactless Thermometer. Anyone who tests higher than the guidelines put out by the CDC will be isolated and rechecked. The Camp Ranger/Medic decision on whether to remain or go home is final.

As you can see, we are doing everything we can do to keep you safe but there is inherent risks of attending this or any other event. We need your help to monitor and correct any situation you may notice while enjoying the camp.

Pre-Event/Pre-Departure Medical Screening Checklist

(Revised September 4, 2020)

Leaders/Parent/Guardian

This checklist must be completed for each Scout **AND** Adult in your unit who is attending any camp, activity, or training conducted in the Golden Spread Council or Districts within the council **BEFORE** they depart home for the camp/activity, or training. Upon arrival at the event, this checklist **must** be turned in to Medical personnel, the Camp Director, or Event Chairperson for each participant. Any scout or adult without this checklist completed and signed, will **NOT** be allowed to remain at the camp or event and all participants who are in the same vehicle (or any other means of transportation) will remain isolated and risk being sent home. The decision of the Medical personnel is final.

Question #1:

Has the participant had any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours?

Fever (100.4 F or greater) Vomiting Diarrhea - None of these

If the participant has fever, vomiting, OR diarrhea—he or she should stay home.

Question #2:

Has the participant had any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours?

Unexplained extreme fatigue or muscle aches Rash Cough Sore throat Open sore None of these

If the participant has any two (or more) of these symptoms—he or she should stay home. If the participant has one of these symptoms, discuss any limitations and restrictions and consider having him or her stay home.

Question #3:
