- Class sign-up must be done when registering online. The Scout will choose a merit badge for the AM class and a different merit badge for the PM class. Scouts can earn two merit badges.

### **Merit Badges for OKPIK Winter Adventure**

#### **“VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION”**

Please explain to your scouts they will be given a Merit Badge Worksheet for each class when they arrive at the class. The scout will be responsible for getting these signed by the Counselor at the end of the class and turned in to their Counselor. The Counselor will put either Complete or Incomplete on the worksheet. The worksheet can be pickup by the Scoutmaster

at the Saturday Night Leader Meeting. If the Scout does not get this taken care of, it is on the Scout NOT THE COUNSELOR!

All merit badges will start at 8:15am and end at 5:45pm on Saturday February 20,2021. The scout must choose which merit badges he/she would like to earn and sign up for the merit badges when doing online registration. The merit badge counselors are asking that Unit Leaders look at the merit badges that their scouts sign up for and if there is any material needed for the merit badge, that the scout provides these material **“THIS HELPS KEEP DOWN Event COST”**. The counselors have also asked that the **“SCOUT BRING WRITING MATERIALS”**. The counselor may ask the class to finish up the classwork after dinner on Saturday night if needed but this will be up to the counselor. There is a counselor for each merit badge that we have to offer our scouts this year. Depending on class size, some of the adults in camp may be asked to help control and assist.

### **Merit Badges**

- Scouting Heritage
- Photography **“The Scouts will need to bring a camera with a removable SD card for printing pictures, iPhone 11 or 12 will work. The instructor is not very proficient with Androids but will do his/her best. A “point and shoot” camera is fine as long as the memory card can be removed.**
- Wood Working **“Must have two Kits for the class. Scouts who have registered for this class will have an added \$10 fee to cover the two required kits. They will be at camp for you.”**
- Welding **“Leather Gloves and Boots Required and Old Clothes No Class A”**.
- Drafting
- Communication
- Not a MB Class but will be available for any Scout who needs this---First Class Orienteering for Scouts working on First Class Rank.

### **Extra Scout and Adult Classes**

- Eagle Support Class -Class will be offered Sunday at 9:00am.

### **“WHAT TROOP UNITS MUST BRING”**

- Scouts must bring clothing that can get dirty or ruined while doing the merit badge for example- Welding. They should read about the merit badge they are registering for and

see if they need any special supplies and bring them. Camp will provide merit badge worksheets for the Classes.

### **“Scouts Must Provide Writing Material”!!!**

- We are asking Troops if they have any tarps that might work to put up on the porch to set up extra meeting spaces please bring them it might be a “GREAT HELP”.

- **“FOOD MUST BE TURNED IN”!!!**

You must turn in all your food to the Kitchen Staff at arriving to Camp at Check-in before setting up your Campsite. **“Mr. Bentley is over the kitchen this year and he has asked that the Troops bring Gallon Size Zip Lock Bags and label their food with their Troop Number so he knows who to give extra food back to at the end of the camp”.**

### **“MEALS”**

- Meals will be provided by Troops. Whatever it takes to feed your unit, you must bring, for example if your unit wants 2 pieces of sausage for breakfast and you have a head count of 10 it would take 20 pieces to feed your unit  $10 \times 2 = 20$ . **We also ask that you bring enough food to feed two extra people per unit.** Meals will be prepared by kitchen staff and served. **“You must also provide Paper Plates, Paper Towels and eating utensils for your unit. We are asking that you bring a Camp Cup that can be washed and reused”!!!**

### **“FOOD LIST”**

- **LUNCH: {FOOD YOU MUST BRING}.** Jimmy Dean Fully Cooked Sausage Patties 24 count, Eggs, Frozen Waffles, Instant Oatmeal, Butter, Syrup, Muffins, Juice, Hot Chocolate, 2 pounds of Hamburger Meat, Two-15oz Cans Diced Tomatoes, One-15oz Can Tomato Sauce, Two-15oz Cans Ranch Style Beans, One Party Size Bags of Frito Chips, Two Packets of McCormick Mild Chilly Mix, One Box of Saltine Crackers, Loafs of Bread, Cookies.
- Dinner – Provided by Ben Ed Hillhouse and Troop 472”
- Also, please bring Fruit and Peanut Butter for snacks during the day and that will be available before meals. **“REMEMBER WHATEVER IT WOULD TAKE TO FEED YOUR TROOP PLUS TWO EXTRA GUESTS IS WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING”.**

## Camp Safety
