

2021 Polaris Resident Camp

June 13 to June 16

Camp MK Brown



This camp is open to registered Scouts BSA with a rank of scout, tenderfoot, or second class. Each scout will be working on the requirements needed for these ranks. Most of the requirements are completed at camp, however some may not be completed due to time restraints or other circumstances. When the scout returns from camp, the unit should be able to easily complete any remaining requirements, and the scout should achieve First Class rank within 3 months upon return.

Each scout must have a parent/guardian present in camp for supervision, or two-deep leadership must be met through leaders of the troop. If this is not possible, leadership needs to be addressed PRIOR to registering for this camp.

The fee for this camp is \$110.00 per scout. Pricing for scouts includes all meals (Sunday (two meals), Monday (three meals), Tuesday, (three meals), Wednesday (two meals), 3 nights of camping, all program supplies, camp support, and a fully trained staff. The fee for adults is \$45.00 and includes the same meals listed above, 3 nights of camping, and camp support!

CHECK-IN BEGINS AT 10:00am on Sunday! After check-in you will have time to set-up camp. The camp starts at noon with lunch in the Dining Hall.

CHECK-OUT BEGINS at 5:00pm on Wednesday. *All scouts will need to be picked up and have departed camp by 6:00pm.* Scouts will be able to pick the Completion Form for the ranks at that time. It is the scouts' responsibility to give the forms to their Scoutmasters so they can be recorded. Scouts will need to complete any requirements back at the unit that were not done at camp.

Attached is friendly reminder of the things to bring to camp.

Also bring for EACH CAMPER & ADULT on camp a completed medical form. This can be found at https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001_abc.pdf.

Please note: Scouts /Adults **DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL TO SIGN THIS FORM.** Part A and B are both required!

Each of the units should keep a copy of this form on hand in case there is any need for it.

Each adult and youth will need a complete and sign by a parent (for youth), the Covid-19 Pre-Event/Pre-Departure Medical Form found at <https://goldenspread.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/11/Pre-EventPre-Departure-Medical-Screening-Checklist-Revised-Nov-2020.pdf>
