



2021 Shooting Sports Camp

July 12 to July 14

Camp MK Brown

This camp is open to registered Scouts BSA members. Each scout will choose **one** of the following three badges that are offered: Rifle Shooting, Shotgun Shooting, and Archery. All the requirements are anticipated to be completed at this camp pending successful participation and qualification!

Each scout must have a parent/guardian present in camp for supervision, or two-deep leadership must be met through leaders of the troop. If this isn't possible, leadership needs to be addressed **PRIOR** to registering for this camp.

The fee for this camp is \$110.00 per scout. Pricing for scouts includes all meals (Monday (lunch and dinner), Tuesday, (three meals), and Wednesday, (two meals), 2 nights of camping, all program supplies, camp support, and a fully trained staff. The fee for adults is \$45.00 and includes the same meals listed above, 2 nights of camping, and camp support!

CHECK-IN BEGINS AT 10:00am on Monday! After check-in you will have time to set-up camp. The camp starts at Noon with lunch in the Dining Hall.

CHECK-OUT BEGINS at 5:00pm on Wednesday. *All scouts will need to be picked up and have departed camp by 6:00pm.* Scouts will be able to pick up their Completion Form for the merit badge at that time. It is the scouts responsibility to give the forms to the Scoutmasters so they can be recorded. Scouts will need to complete any requirements back at the unit that were not successfully completed at this camp.

Attached is a friendly reminder of the things to pack for camp. We anticipate scouts and adults having the opportunity to use the lake if desired!

Also bring for EACH CAMPER & ADULT, a completed medical form. This can be found at https://filestore.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/680-001_abc.pdf.

Please note: Scouts and Adults **DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL TO SIGN THIS FORM.** Part A and B are both required!

Each unit should keep your forms on hand in case there is any need for it.

Each adult and youth will need a completed and signed (by a parent for youth), the Covid-19 Pre-Event/Pre-Departure Medical Form found at <https://goldenspread.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/11/Pre-EventPre-Departure-Medical-Screening-Checklist-Revised-Nov-2020.pdf>

Campsites will be determined by the Camp Ranger and Camp Director. However, if there is a medical necessity or disability we should be aware of, please notify the Scout Service Center at 806-358-6500 prior to registration so we can make those arrangements.

Please, DO NOT bring any personal guns/ammo as we will provide everything needed. You may however, bring your own shooting glasses and ear protection if you have them.

WHAT TO PACK:

Field Uniform (Class "A") **for all Dinner Meals** (Scouts typically wear Class "B" shirts the remainder of the time in camp.)

Tent & Camping Chair

Sleeping Bag & Pillow

Day Pack or Backpack

Water Bottle or Canteen

Sunscreen & Bug Spray

Hat

Jacket & warm clothes for cool nights

Flashlight

Soap & Shampoo (remember a Scout is Clean)

Toothbrush & Paste

Scout Handbook, Notebook, & Pencil/Pen

Swimsuit (ladies- one-piece bathing suits)

Plastic Trash Bags (for dirty or wet clothes)

Bath Towel/Lake Towel

Socks & Shoes (Closed toe & sandals for shower)

Pants & Extra T-shirts

Pajamas or Sleep Wear

Rain Gear or Poncho

Snacks (Need to be kept in closed containers)

Medication as needed
