

# Wilderness First Aid Training

Wilderness First Aid is the assessment of and treatment given to an ill or injured person in a remote environment where definitive care by a physician and/or rapid transport is not readily available. This course goes far beyond what you may know as “first aid”. After completing this course, you will be better prepared in a remote situation. At least one person who is planning on attending ANY Scout High Adventure Base is required to complete this course but it’s open to any adult and youth 14 years of age and up who wants this certification.
