This class is conducted by experts in the field of Environmental Science in both the academic setting and the real world. While earning the Environmental Science merit badge, Scouts will get a taste of what it is like to be an environmental scientist, making observations and carrying out experiments to investigate the natural world. Environmental Science is one of the required merit badges for the World Conservation Award for Scouts BSA, and one of the required merit badges for the William T. Hornaday Awards for Scouts BSA.

- **Registration takes place online beginning October 17 at 4pm. This will be a first come-first serve online registration.** Please visit www.goldenspread.org and click on the calendar then "Environmental Science Merit Badge".
- Individual and troop registrations will be accepted, but each participant must be named during the registration process.
- Due to COVID-19 guidelines and WT A&M Univ guidelines, we can only have 75 Scouts and their instructors on the camp so NO Adults will be able to attend as observers this year.
- Lunch will be served as will snacks. All instructors will disinfect each piece of equipment. Hand sanitizer will be required before any scout enters an activity. Scouts are highly encouraged to bring and wear masks.
- Water bottles are encouraged as well as a hat and sunscreen. Dress for the weather.

- ♦ **Registration ends on November 7 unless the class is full before this date..**
- ♦ Credit Card payments will be accepted. Payments made by check or mail must be paid within 3 days after registration to keep your slots.

- ♦ This will be an outdoor event- no classroom instruction! Everything will be hands on! All requirements will be completed.
- ♦ This is a rain or shine event.
- ♦ Bring a hat and camera (if you want to take photos)
- ♦ Bring a small clipboard and pen

- ♦ Bring a change of shoes (NO open toe shoes will be allowed)
