Registration/Information

- Each Troop should designate **ONE** Adult to enter each Scout's Registration
- **Registration is done online at www.goldenspread.org—see the calendar tab**
- Payment may be made by Credit Card or by paying with a check at the office or by mail
- Registration opens on December 10 and closes on January 14 @11:55pm
- No refunds for any reason after January 15
- Most classes have size limitations and most will **NOT** be completed on site. Those that are completed by the instructor are still subject to review by the Unit Leader

Fees

Scouts: \$35.00. Includes worksheets, breakfast snacks, lunch, and facility use fee.

Adults: \$15.00. Includes breakfast snacks, lunch, facility use fee.

Other

- ♦ Check-in and Opening will be at the **Alumni Banquet Facility (#24 on the map). Parking is in the lot between this facility and the Activity Center (used in the past for check-in)** Classes will take place at the Classroom Center (#3 on the map) and Scouts/Adults will walk there after the Opening.
- ♦ Scouts and Leaders will have lunch in the Dining Hall (#23 on the map) and will walk there after class dismisses.

Leadership Information

- Each Troop must have at least 2 registered leaders at the event to provide proper supervision. All adults must pay the adult fee.
- Adults may attend any merit badge class to provide supervision and attend any adult training/briefing offered.
- **Youth Protection Training will be conducted in the AM and PM.**

Adult Classes

- Youth Protection Trainings (morning and afternoon option). **Great time to get this taken care of BEOFRE Rechartering of your Unit.**
- Adult Briefing Sessions (many different topics will be discussed)

Online Registration Tips

- ♦ Once you add each **Scout and Adult** in the system, just click the “Submit” button. That will bring you to the payment page. **NO** Walk-in’s!
- ♦ You may pay by Credit Card or check
- ♦ **If paying by Check or other form, click on the button at the end of the “Credit/Debit Card” box. You must hit the “Submit” Button again. If you don’t or don’t get a email confirmation, the registration did not go through.**

Note: Merit Badge registration is on a first-come first-serve basis. Merit Badges offered may change without notice due to instructor availability. Individual Scout schedules will be provided at check-in.

Disclaimer: All Merit Badge work should be checked to ensure it’s been completed prior to issuing the Merit Badge. Instructors do their best to complete the requirements as listed but ultimately it’s the Unit responsibility to ensure they have all been met. Partial credit may be given at the Merit Badge University.

Other: We will mail each Scoutmaster the list of requirements that were or were not completed within 2 weeks after the event is over along with the instructors contact information in case you want to follow-up.

Important Step by Step Instructions

1. Distribute Scout/Adult Registration Forms to each person in the Troop.
2. Ask them to complete and return to you on the date you impose.
3. Enter the desired classes in the online system– Be careful **not to duplicate class times!**
4. Register one Scout and one Adult at a time.
5. Pay online or mail/come by the office.

QUICK FAQ's:

◆ **How do I register Scouts and Adults?**

All registration is completed online at www.goldenspread.org– go the Calendar and scroll to Jan 22– MBU

◆ **How much does the MBU Cost?**

Scouts are \$35.00 and Adults are \$15.00. No cost increase this year for adults!

◆ **I'm an adult who isn't going to attend any training but will be providing leadership as needed. Do I still have to pay?**

Yes! All adults must pay the fee to cover facility fees cost share, breakfast items, and lunch. No discount if not eating.

◆ **When will the Scouts receive their firm schedule of classes?**

Scouts and adults will receive their schedules at check-in along with classroom locations and other great information

◆ **If I have a Scout who has to cancel, will he receive a refund?**

Refunds are not given for cancellations after January 15th, however another Scout can take his place with no schedule changes allowed.

◆ **What Uniform should the Scout wear?**

Scouts should wear their Field Uniform (aka- Class A). Adults are encouraged to wear their Field Uniform as well.

◆ **What materials will the Scouts receive when they attend class?**

Each class participant will receive a printed Merit Badge Worksheet to follow along with the instructor. They keep these when class is over to help them finish the merit badge or prove to the scout leader that they accomplished the requirements.

◆ **Since it's winter time, what if the weather turns bad?**

Depending on the advice of the local authorities and WT A&M University Staff, the council will do it's best to notify everyone of any changes or cancellation of the event.

Emails will be sent to those **who registered their Scouts** as soon as possible. Not every scout or leader will get an email! Watch the Council's Facebook Page as well! Refunds will not be offered if the event is not cancelled or rescheduled by the event staff.

◆ **I have scouts who want to enroll in a class that shows "Full". What happens now?**

Each class has a designated size based on the difficulty of the badge and the desire of the instructor. Registration is first come – first serve. On the form that you gave to the Scout to determine which badges he was interested in, allowed for multiple choices. You should choose an alternative class that still has availability.

◆ **Can I call the Scout Service Center and see if I can get another Scout in a "full" class?**

No! The class size is set by the instructor, the classroom size, and difficulty of the material.

◆ **If I have any questions, who should I call?**
