The Polar Bear Award is available to any registered Cub Scout, Boy Scouts, Venturer, and Scouter who can meet the following requirements:

1. Plan an overnight at one of our council camps or another camping location.
2. Sleep in a tent, tarp, lean-to, or improvised shelter at below freezing temperatures and cook at least two meals.
3. Two BSA registered adult leaders must be in camp when the applicant qualifies for this award. They are responsible for the health, safety, and welfare of all participants.
4. Two deep leadership is required at all times.
